

## HOW TO SUBMIT BOOKS FOR CONSIDERATION:

- A book can be nominated by its publisher, translator, author or illustrator. The nominator should submit a completed submission form to GLLI director Rachel Hildebrandt Reynolds ([rehildebrandt@gmail.com](mailto:rehildebrandt@gmail.com)). If the nominator is not the publisher, then GLLI will contact the publisher to request submission. Publishers have the right to accept or reject nominations of their titles.
- Publishers are to mail one hardcopy and email one digital copy (PDF preferred) of the book to GLLI Director Rachel Reynolds (Rachel Reynolds, 2027 Spencer Hill Rd., Corning, NY 14830; [rehildebrandt@gmail.com](mailto:rehildebrandt@gmail.com)). Digital copies will not be distributed outside the committee. Hardcopies will be retained by GLLI for a permanent collection of YA literature, and indexed in GLLI's database of children's and YA literature in translation.
- There is no entry fee for this prize.
- If books were published in 2018 or 2019 and previously submitted for the award, there is no need to resubmit. The committee will consider eligible earlier submissions for the 2021 prize. Only titles from 2018 or 2019 that were not shortlisted may be considered for the 2021 award, at the discretion of the committee.

GLLI will confirm the receipt of all books submitted. If you have mailed in books for consideration and have not received confirmation after a reasonable amount of time, please contact the GLLI director ([rehildebrandt@gmail.com](mailto:rehildebrandt@gmail.com)).

The 2021 award will be announced on International Children's Book Day, April 2, which commemorates Hans Christian Andersen's birthday. The prize will be granted in conjunction with ALA's Annual Conference, generally in June or July.
